Washington, DC (December 12, 2007) – Water Systems Council (WSC) received the 2007 Groundwater Association Champion Award. The award was presented Wednesday, November 28 at the 2007 Groundwater Foundation National Conference and Groundwater Guardian Designation in Lakewood, Colorado. Gerry Duggan, WSC's incoming president, accepted the award, along with WSC Executive Director Kathleen Stanley.
