The Water Systems Council

Founded in 1932, the Water Systems Council (WSC) is the only national nonprofit organization with programs solely focused on private wells and small, shared wells serving more than 13 million households nationwide (U.S. Census American Housing Survey 2015).


WSC is committed to ensuring that Americans who depend on wells have safe, reliable drinking water and works to educate well owners, consumers, and policymakers at local, state, and federal levels about water wells and the importance of protecting America's groundwater resources.

The Water Systems Council's wellcare® program is a dedicated program protecting the water supply and groundwater resources for U.S. households that depend on private water wells for their drinking water.

The program provides consumers with education and information services that stress the importance of proper construction, regular testing and maintenance, and provides decision makers with information about wells.
